NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Pekin Country Club scorecard or any other posted local rules**. In addition, the following specific rules apply:

- 1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play with the field being cut after 36 holes to the low 42 boys and ties and the low 24 girls and ties. The competition will not extend beyond Thursday, July 10, 2025.
- 2. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLUE** tees. **Girls** will be playing from the **RED** tees.
- 3. **OUT OF BOUNDS**: Out of bounds is defined by the inside edge of roads, white stakes, and property fence posts of walls at ground level.
 - During play of hole No. 16 **ONLY**, the white stakes along the right side of the hole define out of bounds. These stakes are treated as boundary objects during the play of hole No. 16. For all other holes they are immovable obstructions.
- 4. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR PUTTING GREEN**: Ground under repair on the putting green is defined by white dots. If a player's ball is ON the putting green and there is interference by the ground under repair the player may take relief in accordance with Rule 16.1d. The nearest point of complete relief may be off the putting green. There is no relief for line of play if the ball is OFF the putting green.
- 5. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
- 6. <u>ADVICE</u>: (Rule 10.2a) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
- 7. <u>COMMITTEE</u>: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of AJGA Tournament Director Andrew Wagner, AJGA Tournament Assistant Charlie Turner, and Head Golf Professional Matt Schuerman, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
