NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Trinity Forest Golf Club scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 18 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Monday, July 20, 2026.
2. **PLAYOFFS**: All playoffs for the final qualifying spots will proceed from the No. 1 tee.
 - A playoff for the Girls Division will begin at 2:15
 - A playoff for the Boys Division will begin at 2:30 p.m.

NOTE: If play is delayed for any reason the starting time for the qualifier playoff will also be delayed. If applicable, this will be communicated to players on-site.
3. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLUE** tees.
 Girls will be playing from the **RED** tees.
4. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at Trinity Forest Golf Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: South Driving Range and Practice Putting Green near clubhouse. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
5. **DOUBLE GREEN (NOS. 2 & 12)**: The green serving No. 2 and 12 is considered to be two separate greens divided by blue stakes. A player who has interference with the portion of the green for the hole not being played is on a wrong green and must take relief under Rule 13.1f.
6. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN**: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect. For a ball in the general area, relief is allowed only when both the ball and the immovable obstruction lie in an area cut to fairway height or less. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play and is either on or within two-club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

NOTE: Grass covered sprinkler heads are considered immovable obstructions. If the grass covering is loose the player may put it back.
7. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS – ROCK/SAND CART PATHS**: The rock/sand cart paths designed for cart traffic are immovable obstructions. The manmade walking paths are not immovable obstructions and free relief will NOT be granted.
8. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
9. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
10. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Kelly O'Neil, Tournament Director Faith Scott, and Assistant Tournament Director Jaryn Sundby, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
