NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on The Woodlands Country Club scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 18 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Sunday, June 14, 2026.
2. **PLAYOFFS**: All playoffs for the final qualifying spots will proceed from the No. 18 tee.
 - A playoff for the Girls Division will begin at 2:00 p.m.
 - A playoff for the Boys Division will begin at 2:15 p.m.**NOTE**: If play is delayed for any reason the starting time for the qualifier playoff will also be delayed. If applicable, this will be communicated to players on-site.
3. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLACK** tees.
Girls will be playing from the **WHITE** tees.
4. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at The Woodlands Country Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: The practice putting green, the driving range and the short game area. Following each round, players will have 90 minutes for practice starting immediately when the player leaves the scoring area. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
5. **OUT OF BOUNDS**: Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts and the inside edge of a paved road or curb. When out of bounds is defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. Out of bounds is also defined by:
 - The water's edge on the opposite side of the penalty area on No. 4, No. 7, No. 14, and No. 17
6. **DECORATIVE ROCKS**: Rocks used in decorative ways (ie., walls, around flower beds, and trees or walkways) are deemed to be immovable obstructions.
7. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
8. **ADVICE**: (**Rule 10.2a**) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
9. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Tournament Director Andrew Wagner, and Tournament Assistant Grace Dabbelt, and Head Golf Professional Kevin Kelchner will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
