NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2019 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Country Club of St. Alban's scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Friday, July 9, 2021.
2. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLACK** tees.
Girls will be playing from the **WHITE** tees.
3. **AJGA DROPPING ZONE (YELLOW PENALTY AREA)**: If a ball is in the yellow penalty area in front of the greens of No. 4, 11, or 15, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball has come to rest in the penalty area, the player has these relief options, each for one penalty stroke:
 - a. Take relief under Rule 17.1, or
 - b. As an extra option, drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located in the fairway before the yellow penalty area. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3
4. **TUNNEL ENTRANCE OUT OF BOUNDS**: A ball is considered out of bounds if it crosses the tunnel entrance that leads from No. 1 to No. 2. A player must take stroke-and-distance relief by adding one penalty stroke and playing the original ball or another ball from where the previous stroke was made under Rule 18.2.
5. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
6. **AJGA CODE OF CONDUCT (SOCIAL DISTANCING)**: The AJGA's Code of Conduct policy is always in effect when a player is at the host facility. This policy includes social distancing for players and their family members. Please reference the AJGA Code of Conduct policy.
7. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official David Thompson, Tournament Director Thomas Harrison, Midwest Regional Director Ryan Flanagan, and Tournament Assistant Greta Rux, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
