NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2019 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the TPC Sawgrass – THE PLAYERS Stadium Course scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT:** The championship consists of 54 holes of stroke play. The Junior PLAYERS Championship will not extend beyond Sunday, September 5, 2021.
2. **TOURNAMENT TEES:** Play will be from the **BLUE** tee markers.
3. **DAMAGE TO PUTTING GREEN EDGES:** For interference from damage to the edges of putting greens, for a ball lying **on the putting green**, a player may lift the ball and place it or another ball on the nearest spot **on the putting green** not nearer the hole that affords **complete relief for lie of ball and line of play**.
 - There is no relief from line of play for a ball that lies off the putting green.
4. **AJGA DROPPING ZONES – PENALTY AREA:** As an additional option for a ball that is in or is lost in a penalty area (Rule 17.1), the following AJGA dropping zones may be used, even though they may be closer to the hole than the point where the ball last crossed the edge of the penalty area:
 - No. 13 on a forward tee
 - No. 17 on the forwardmost tee
5. **NO. 17:** The wooden walkway is an immovable obstruction. Railings and ropes are all considered to be part of the same obstruction. At the players discretion, the ropes may be considered to be movable or immovable obstructions BUT must be replaced if they are moved. The edge of the yellow penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the same obstruction.
6. **NO. 4 NO PLAY ZONE:** The newly laid sod in the rough to the right of No. 4 identified by blue stakes is a No Play Zone. Players **MUST** take relief in accordance with Rule 16.1f.
7. **INTEGRAL OBJECTS:** The following items are deemed to be integral objects, from which free relief will **NOT** be granted:
 - Artificial retaining walls and pilings within penalty areas.
 - Paths covered with soil, dirt or crushed shell.
8. **AREAS ENCLOSED BY CART PATH:** All areas enclosed by a cart path (i.e. flowerbeds) are deemed to be a part of the cart path, and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.
9. **FRESHLY PAINTED LINES:** Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must only use freshly painted lines.
10. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
11. **COMMITTEE:** The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Larry Startzel, Tournament Director Nathan Nottrott and Assistant Tournament Director Andrew Greenfield, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
