NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Bay View Golf Club scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Sunday, April 19, 2026.
2. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLACK** tees.
Girls will be playing from the **GOLD** tees.
3. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at Bay View Golf Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: The practice putting green, short game area and the driving range. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
4. **OUT OF BOUNDS**: Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts and the inside edge of a paved or gravel road or curb. When out of bounds is defined by a white line the line itself is out of bounds. Out of bounds is also defined by:
 - a. The water's edge on the opposite side of the red penalty area on No. 7.

NOTE: The black fence that crosses in front of the tees on No. 2 does not define out of bounds.
5. **RED PENALTY AREA FENCE – NO. 11**: The red penalty area left of No. 11 green is defined by the metal fence posts. A ball is considered to be in the red penalty area when the ball lies beyond the fence line. The fence is an immovable obstruction from which a player can get free relief in accordance with Rule 16.1b.
6. **WRONG GREEN (NO. 6)**: The additional nursery putting green to the right of No. 6 is a wrong green. If any part of the player's ball touches, lies on and is inside the edge of the wrong green or the wrong green interferes with the player's area of intended stance or area of intended swing, free relief **MUST** be taken in accordance with Rule 13.1f(2).
7. **SANDY AREAS**: The unprepared areas of sand between Nos. 8 & 9 are part of the general area and are not bunkers.
8. **WIRED CAGING**: All wired caging within the general area is treated as an immovable obstruction and free relief will be granted in accordance with Rule 16.1b. Players will not be granted line of play relief under this rule.
9. **BURROWING ANIMAL HOLES**: Rule 16.1a is modified in this way: Interference **ONLY** exists when a burrowing animal hole interferes with the lie of ball. Relief will not be granted for interference with a player's stance or swing.
10. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**: On the putting green, if a player's ball comes to rest in the ground under repair identified by white dots, or if the player has interference from line of play, the player may place a ball at the nearest point of complete relief. The ball must lie **ON** the putting green to be granted relief.
11. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
12. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
13. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Dan Morelock, Tournament Director Jayce Carsten, and Assistant Tournament Director Nick Cortese, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
