**NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card.

**Disregard any local rules on the Mission Hills Country Club – Pete Dye Challenge Course scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Friday, June 12, 2026.
2. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **BLUE** tees.  
**Girls** will be playing from the **WHITE** tees.
3. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at Mission Hills Country Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: Both practice putting greens, the driving range and the short game area. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
4. **OUT OF BOUNDS**: Out of Bounds is defined by the outside edge of cart paths, white stakes, property fence posts, or walls at any height at ground level. Out of Bounds also includes the following:
  - The water's edge of the red penalty areas on Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, 12, 13, 14, 17, and 18 on the opposite margin which is Out of Bounds.
  - The outside edge of the cart path on Nos. 1, 5, 6, 10, 11, 13, 14, and 15 defines Out of Bounds. The white lines identify Out of Bounds.
5. **SANDY AREAS**: The sandy areas are considered part of the general area and not bunkers. Players may lightly ground their club and are entitled to relief from the immovable obstructions within the sandy areas in accordance with Rule 16.1b.
6. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
7. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
8. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Dan Morelock, Tournament Director Rob Cleary, and Tournament Assistant Jaryn Sundby, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
