## AJGA WICHITA JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP presented by TGC GROUP

## NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Terradyne Country Club scorecard or any other posted local rules**. In addition, the following specific rules apply:

- 1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Friday, August 1, 2024.
- 2. <u>TOURNAMENT TEES</u>: Boys will be playing from the BLUE tees. Girls will be playing from the RED tees.
- 1. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at Terradyne Country Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: Practice putting green, short game area, and the driving range. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
- 2. <u>OUT OF BOUNDS</u>: Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes, fence posts, brick walls, and the inside edge of a paved road or curb.
- 3. **PENALTY AREA (NO. 8)**: Where the artificial wall surrounds the edge of the pond in front of the tee on No. 8, the penalty area is defined by the outside edge of the wall.
- 4. <u>INTEGRAL OBJECTS</u>: The artificial turf on the inside edges of bunkers is considered to be an integral object. Relief without penalty is not allowed if a player's ball lies on or against the artificial turf, or of it interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing.
- 5. **DOUBLE GREENS**: The green serving holes Nos. 1 & 8 and 15 & 18 are considered to be two separate greens divided by blue stakes on the edge of the green. A player who has interference with the portion of the green for the hole not being played is on a wrong green and must take relief under Rule 13.1f.
- 6. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
- 7. ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
- 8. <u>COMMITTEE</u>: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Tournament Director Trevon Wehrman, Tournament Assistant Ava Lassiter, and Head Golf Professional Brian Ward will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
