NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the OakWing Golf Club scorecard or any other posted local rules.** In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT:** 18 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Thursday, March 12, 2026.
2. **PLAYOFFS:** All playoffs for the final qualifying spots will proceed from the No. 18 tee.
 - A playoff for the Girls Division will begin at 3 p.m.
 - A playoff for the Boys Division will begin at 3:15 p.m.**NOTE:** If play is delayed for any reason the starting time for the qualifier playoff will also be delayed. If applicable, this will be communicated to players on-site.
3. **TOURNAMENT TEES:** **Boys** will be playing from the **BLUE** tees.
Girls will be playing from the **RED** tees.
4. **PRACTICE FACILITIES:** The following areas at OakWing Golf Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: The practice putting green, the driving range and the short game area. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
5. **OUT OF BOUNDS:** Out of bounds is defined by the line between the course-side points at ground level of white stakes and fence posts and the inside edge of a paved road or curb.
NOTE:
 - The road that crosses between play on No. 13 does **NOT** define out of bounds. This road is an immovable obstruction.
6. **NO PLAY ZONE (PENALTY AREA):** The cemetery located within the red penalty area to the left of No. 6 green, marked by red stakes with green tops, is designated as a no play zone. When a ball is in the no play zone within the penalty area, the ball must not be played as it lies and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 17.1e.
NOTE:
 - Additionally, for a ball outside the penalty area, a player **MUST** take free relief if the cemetery interferes with their intended swing or stance.
7. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR (PUTTING GREEN):** Ground under repair on the putting green is defined by white dots. If a player's ball is ON the putting and there is interference by the ground under repair, including the player's line of play, the player may take relief in accordance with Rule 16.1d. The nearest point of complete relief may be off the putting green. There is no relief for line of play if the ball is OFF the putting green.
8. **FADED LINES:** Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
9. **ADVICE: (Rule 10.2a)** is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
10. **COMMITTEE:** The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Tournament Director Mary Caines, Assistant Tournament Director Sophia Thomas, and Assistant Tournament Director Kelly Shorba will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
