## NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the Le Triomphe Golf & Country Club scorecard or any other posted local rules**. In addition, the following specific rules apply:

- 1. **FORMAT**: 54 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Sunday, October 12, 2025.
- 2. TOURNAMENT TEES: Boys will be playing from the BLACK tees. Girls will be playing from the WHITE tees.
- 3. **PRACTICE FACILITIES:** The following areas at Le Triomphe Golf & Country Club are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: The practice putting greens, the driving range, and the short game area. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
- 4. <u>TEMPORARY IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION (TIOs):</u> The following items are temporary immovable obstructions. Players may take relief in accordance with Model Local Rule F-23.
  - a. Tournament signage
  - b. Greenside fan on No. 14
  - c. AJGA starting tents
  - d. AJGA scoring tents
- 5. **RED PENALTY AREAS (Model Local Rule B-2.2)**: If the ball last crossed the edge of a red penalty area that coincides with a boundary of the course, as an extra relief option for one penalty stroke, the player may drop the original ball or another ball on the opposite side in the general area.
- 6. **ROADS AND PATHS:** All gravel paths on the course, even if not artificially surfaced, are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1.
- 7. <u>IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Riprap stone walls)</u>: Riprap stone walls when located in penalty areas are immovable obstructions. Free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1 when your ball lies **outside** the penalty area.
- 8. NO PLAY ZONES GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Sodded Areas): Areas circled by white lines and identified by white stakes with a green top are No Play Zones and are to be treated as abnormal course conditions. Free relief must be taken from interference by the No Play Zone under Rule 16.1f.
- 9. **FADED LINES:** Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
- 10. <u>ADVICE</u>: (Rule 10.2a) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
- 11. <u>COMMITTEE</u>: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Larry Startzel, Tournament Director Garret Fassett, and Assistant Tournament Director Matthew O'Connell, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
