NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card. **Disregard any local rules on the East Potomac Golf Links – Blue Course scorecard or any other posted local rules**. In addition, the following specific rules apply:

- 1. **FORMAT**: 18 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Monday, July 7, 2025.
- 2. <u>PLAYOFFS</u>: All playoffs for the final qualifying spots will proceed from the No. 10 tee.
 - A playoff for the Girls Division will begin at 1:15 p.m.
 - A playoff for the Boys Division will begin at 1:25 p.m.
 NOTE: If play is delayed for any reason the starting time for the qualifier playoff will also be delayed. If applicable, this will be communicated to players on-site.
- 3. **TOURNAMENT TEES:** Boys will be playing from the BLUE tees. Girls will be playing from the RED tees.
- 4. **PRACTICE FACILITIES:** The following areas at East Potomac Golf Links are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: Both practice putting greens, the driving range and the short game area. The short game area will not be available after play. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
- 5. <u>ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Rail Ties):</u> Rail ties used as curbs are considered immovable obstructions and relief will be given under Rule 16.1b.
- 6. <u>ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (Cart Paths):</u> The following is considered to be an abnormal course condition under Rule 16.1: All dirt and gravel cart paths found on the course.
- 7. **FADED LINES:** Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
- 8. <u>ADVICE</u>: (Rule 10.2a) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
- 9. <u>COMMITTEE</u>: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official Dan Morelock, Tournament Director Thomas Harrison, and Tournament Assistant Brooke Heidebrecht, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
