COMMITMENT LETTER

1. The Matches will be conducted under the jurisdiction of the American Junior Golf Association (AJGA).
2. The Wyndham Cup teams will consist of 20 players each.
3. As a condition of each player's selection to the team, each player grants and assigns all individual media rights, now known or developed in the future, respecting participation in the 2026 Wyndham Cup, in perpetuity, inclusive of, but not limited to, television broadcasting, radio broadcasting, Internet cybercasting, highlight videos and event-specific rights to the AJGA.
4. Team members are expected to attend and participate in ALL activities which are arranged in conjunction with the Wyndham Cup. This includes the closing ceremonies which will follow the conclusion of play Thursday, July 9. These events are important to all who have supported the event including sponsors, the tournament committee, volunteers and the members and staff of Old Sandwich Golf Club.
5. The Team Captains and Assistant Captains will be the final authority with respect to all matters that have to do with the playing activities of the team members in the Wyndham Cup and any special events that take place in conjunction with the Wyndham Cup. The Captains will assign members to compete in the matches based upon their sole judgment and discretion.
6. TaylorMade Golf, adidas, PING and Imperial will provide each team member and captain with official apparel. Team members will be required to wear the established uniform during the Junior-Am day, all three tournament days and at any designated functions held in conjunction with the Wyndham Cup.

I, for myself, the parent, and the player, hereby release and covenant not to sue the host facility, the American Junior Golf Association, its officers, directors, and employees from any and all liability for any event or consequence whatsoever in any way arising out of or relating to members' participation in an AJGA event with the sole and singular exception of liability arising out of bad faith or willful misconduct. This release and covenant not to sue includes, but is not limited to, any claim for personal injury allegedly sustained while participating in an AJGA event.

I, the parent, also acknowledge and assume responsibility for the conduct and safety of the player while he/she is out of my immediate supervision at any AJGA event, and hereby absolve the AJGA of liability for any injury or damage sustained or caused by the player while in attendance at an AJGA event.

We, the player and parent, understand, support and agree to abide by the AJGA's Code of Conduct. We understand that no body paint, hair color or other color product may be used that could lead to the destruction of property. We accept responsibility for the damaged caused by the player to any vehicles, golf carts, towels, furniture or any other golf course property.

I, the parent, also agree that the AJGA may use my child's name and likeness for publicity and promotional purposes under NCAA and USGA guidelines.

In case of emergency during an AJGA tournament, I, the parent, authorize a qualified athletic trainer, EMT or medical professional to take all necessary measures in the treatment of the aforementioned tournament participant.
