NOTICE TO PLAYERS

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf Effective January 2023 and the AJGA Tournament Hard Card.

Disregard any local rules on the Haggin Oaks Golf Complex – Alister MacKenzie Golf Course scorecard or any other posted local rules. In addition, the following specific rules apply:

1. **FORMAT**: 18 holes of stroke play. The competition will not extend beyond Thursday, April 2.
2. **PLAYOFFS**: All playoffs for the final qualifying spots will proceed from the No. 17 tee.
 - A playoff for the Girls Division will begin at 1 p.m.
 - A playoff for the Boys Division will begin at 1:10 p.m.

NOTE: If play is delayed for any reason the starting time for the qualifier playoff will also be delayed. If applicable, this will be communicated to players on-site.
3. **TOURNAMENT TEES**: **Boys** will be playing from the **MacKenzie** tees.
Girls will be playing from the **Four Oaks** tees.
4. **PRACTICE FACILITIES**: The following areas at Haggin Oaks Golf Complex are designated as practice facilities and can be used by AJGA participants: Both practice putting greens, the driving range the short game area and all academy holes. Practice facilities not listed are closed to AJGA participants.
5. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**: The sand pile defined by one blue stake to the left of No. 4 fairway is ground under repair. Players may take relief from this area under Rule 16.1.
6. **NO PLAY ZONE**: The flower bed area defined by one blue stake right of the green on No. 18 is a no play zone that is to be treated as an abnormal course condition. Free relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 16.1f.
7. **FADED LINES**: Disregard all faded ground under repair and penalty area lines. Players must use freshly painted lines.
8. **ADVICE**: (**Rule 10.2a**) is any verbal comment or action that is intended to influence a player in choosing a club, making a stroke or deciding how to play during a hole or round. In addition, any conversation between player/spectator may be construed as advice. This includes any conversation between player/spectator in their native language. In either instance penalty for breach of this rule is two strokes. Players are responsible for the actions of their relatives and spectators in regards to this rule.
9. **COMMITTEE**: The Committee, as defined in the Rules of Golf, consists of the senior rules official, all AJGA staff members present during competition, and any guest rules officials appointed by the tournament director. The Tournament Rules Committee composed of Senior Rules Official John Johnson, Tournament Director Jordan Alejandre, and Assistant Tournament Director Rob Cleary, will have final decision-making authority over all rules-related matters.
